THINGS TO KNOW!

Morning Bunch - Advanced notice required. Drop off anytime between 8AM and 8:45AM. Please sign your child in as usual on the clipboard at the sign-in table and take your child to Room 7, Miss Chris' room, upstairs hallway, north end. Morning Bunch has story time, color time, and game time! Be sure your child has breakfast before they come to school. Your child will be escorted to their room at 9:00AM. The cost is \$7.00/morning. You will be invoiced at the end of each month.

Lunch Bunch - Do you need an extra hour after school for an appointment? Sign up for the Lunch Bunch program! Lunch bunch is a hit with the kids and is convenient for parents. Sign up at check in, have a lunch packed for your child, and that's it! We'll take care of the rest. Pick up is at 1:00PM and the lunch bunch kids will be downstairs in the terrace room. We play games, have interesting activities, and the kids get to eat their lunch together in a social setting! Our fabulous lunch bunch staff help the kids open their lunches, then they get to do art, play fun games, story time, floor tumbling and even some science activities. \$7.00 per session. Monday-game day: Tuesday & Wednesdaysobstacle course day; Thursday-Music; Friday-Theme Day. You will be invoiced at the end of each month.

Volunteer Hours - Each family at Let Me Shine is required to complete 5 volunteer hours during the school year. You may 'opt out' of volunteering with a \$50 payment to LMS. We do hope you'll decide to volunteer it's a great way to meet the kids, parents and staff and learn about the day-to-day activities at Let Me Shine. Here are a few ideas to get you started: Assist in the classroom (with prior arrangement), maintain & straighten storage rooms, at-home projects, book fair volunteers, library maintenance, read to a class, talk about your occupation, etc. Please talk to Holly, Sabrina or your child's teacher about additional opportunities or ideas. Your help is always welcome!

Contact Info - Did you move over the summer? Do you have a new phone number, work number or cell number? Please update your personal contact information in the school office. In the event of an emergency, it is essential we have your most current information.

School Pictures - School picture days are scheduled for September 27th and 28th. All children will have class photos taken, and individual purchases are optional. Your teachers will have materials to send home within the next few weeks. Picture packages and pricing will be available at that time.
